Some movement and shooting from behind barriers and/or tables is expected (but this is not a run & gun). Reloading during a stage is required so Semi-Auto Rifles do work better. This month's match we'll be adding the option of using a shotgun for the mid-range targets. Bring a minimum 25 rounds of ammo - lead shot only no larger than #7 ½, more is better. (there may be a bonus target available) We'll still use a Centerfire Rifle / Pistol Caliber Carbine for the long range and Centerfire Pistol for the short range targets. Bring 50 rounds of ammo for each and extra magazines.
