Note 1: Hunter Rifle Manny Carter 971-388-5337 Any centerfire hunting rifle for this shoot. Bring 50 rounds. You will shoot at least 30 rounds regular and maybe 8 rounds running buck.

Note 2: Sporting Clay Dusty Freeman 503-949-8366 Weather permitting. Lead shot only. No shot larger than 7 ½. Bring 75 rounds, will shoot 50 rounds for sure.

Note 3: 3 Gun Rick Reitz 503-580-8086 Bring 150 rounds handgun ammo, 75 rounds rifle ammo, and 50 rounds shotgun ammo (lead shot only size 7 ½ or smaller). 3-Gun is one of the most popular shooting matches in the country today, as well as at Four Corners. If you want to move and shoot while using rifle/pistol/shotgun you are going to like this one. These matches will test your shooting skills, shooting under pressure, around walls, barrels and other props the match director comes up with.

Note 4: Steel Challenge Tim Brown 503-409-5715 Centerfire revolvers and pistol caliber rifles/carbine for this shoot. Bring 50 rounds for each gun.

Note 5: Glock repair Jeff Crandall 503-932-0991 This is an introductory instructor led class for cleaning you Glock pistol.

Note 6: Rim fire fun shoot Greg Plass 503-269-8740 22 Rimfire rifles for this shoot. Bring 100 rounds. The name says everything in evolving event, we shoot with rimfire .22's and it is fun! Events are for both rifle and pistol, watch the calendar for details. New stages and events are added and changed each month...to keep in fun. If you are seeking the keep your skills honed while not expending currently expensive and difficult to source centerfire ammo, this is a great opportunity. And like all the other events, there is no need to practice before shooting a match; the match *is* practice. Cost for the shoot is \$5.00 for members and \$10.00 for non-members.

Note 7: Defensive gun Jeff Crandall 503-932-0991 Centerfire open sights concealed carry handguns or pistol caliber carbines. Participants may shoot one or the other but not both. Bring 150 rounds of ammo, cover garment, holster, if you have one, and several magazines or speed loaders.

Note 8: Bowling pin shoot Tim Brown 503-409-5715 This shoot will be an old fashion bowling pin shoot in memory of member Dale Basl who has passed to that range in the sky. The Bowling Pin Shoot was one of his favorites. Dale left behind hundreds of rounds of .357 and 45 ACP ammo which will be available free for use to supplement what you bring for this shoot. Bring your own if you shoot other than .357 or 45 ACP. We will shoot at least 50 rounds and maybe 100.

Note 9: Archery Jack Wood 503-991-2770 Ten targets. Up to 3 shots at each. No crossbows. No broadheads

Note 10: Pistol Verses Dave Kopecky 503-581-5214 This will be a Verses match – two shooters competing against each other. Centerfire and .22 rimfire handgun. Bring 100 rounds for each gun. You can compete in both center fire hand gun and .22 rim fire hand gun. Bring a friend and see who is the winner.
